



#### **PRAYER CHANGES THINGS:**

It is my goal that EVERY student in grades 6-12 is prayed for, by name, everyday for this year. I look forward to telling each of our students that they are being prayed for by name by someone in our parish. What better way to support the youth in our parish as they continue to grow in their faith and also as they start to ask questions about their faith. Each of the envelopes in the authoring area will contain the names and a little information about three students in our parish. One of the greatest hesitations people experience when thinking about becoming a prayer partner is, "I don't know what to pray for or how to pray." Enclosed in your envelope will be six months worth of calendars. Each day there will be a short specific prayer to say, if you choose to use it. We ask that you fill out the bottom of the letter, to register as a prayer partner. Then we can mail you your second set of prayer calendars in February, but more importantly, we can hold you in prayer also.

Please prayerfully consider taking an envelope after mass, to become a prayer partner for the youth of our parish. If you would prefer an envelope be mailed to you, you can contact Melissa Fox (320-761-2217) or call the main office, and we will get one in the mail to you!

Please remember Bishop Kettler's statement that recommendations from the CDC, MDH and the Governor's Office must be adhered to as closely as is possible. This requires that members of the liturgical assembly MUST wear face coverings and congregational singing is to be omitted. Singing is to be done by cantor ONLY. # Reprimanded by God?

Can you imagine being in the physical presence of Jesus and have him turn to you, personally, and say, "Get behind me Satan!" How shocking would that be for you? How shocking might it have been for Peter, one of the beloved disciples who gave up his life to follow Jesus? Peter was being protective of Jesus in that moment as Jesus had just told his disciples how he would have to suffer, die, and be raised on the third day. Peter could not imagine that his Lord would ever have to endure something so traumatic. He reacted like anyone who loves another person, being certain he would not let such a thing happen. Jesus reprimanded him for thinking as humans think and not as God thinks.

We often find ourselves being so sure that we will not allow a certain outcome for the people we love. As a parent we might think, "I'll do whatever I can so that my child does not have to suffer." Yet, we know by life experience, ours, and that of others, that we are not the one who is in control. Like Peter, we need to be challenged to "think as God thinks, not as humans do". What Jesus was teaching us in this Gospel account was that God has a plan. He has a plan not only for his Son, but for all of us. And it is important to recognize that our human mind cannot comprehend what is necessary to ensure that God's plan is realized.

Jesus teaches the disciples and all people throughout the ages that we must give up our way of thinking and take up the crosses we need to bear to follow him. In effect, surrender to the will of God, just as Jesus surrendered to the will of his Father and lived out his Father's plan. The beauty of that was our salvation. We can only imagine the unknown joy that awaits each of us as we surrender, pick up our crosses and continue to follow Jesus. We know by faith that God is with us every step of the way. We find our strength to carry our crosses in the grace freely given from our loving and caring God.

Take time this week to think about how you might need to surrender to God's will for your life. Do you trust God enough to do so? Do you believe that you are strengthened by the Holy Spirit within you? May we graciously accept the invitation to draw ever closer to God as we surrender to his will for our lives.

Much of our fall festival event will not take place this year. We are unable to gather, socialize and enjoy our outdoor festivities given the current pandemic. However, the Parish Festival generates significant income for the parish budget, so we still plan to have the



big ticket raffle, a quilt raffle, an online auction, and a virtual Franny Flyer run this year on the weekend of September 19-20.

Last year FrantoberFest generated net income of \$63K, with the raffle accounting for nearly half of that. There are great prizes to win — a cash grand prize of \$3,000 as well as gift certificates, products and additional cash prizes. Chances are \$5 each and will be distributed in the Gathering Place starting August 22.

You will also be able to buy quilt raffle tickets for the chance to buy a beautiful handmade quilt. We will keep you posted on plans for the raffle drawing on Sunday, September 20, 2020 at noon.

Without all of the other events of our traditional festival, we will have a financial shortfall. Therefore, we ask all households to prayerfully consider making a \$100 donation to the parish festival this year. This will help with the parish budget that relies on the income from the Parish Festival.
